

Privacy and cookie statement News.horse

1. This privacy and cookie statement applies to all information that is collected or used by News.horse (BV io), the brand name of BYDA Management BV for the time being.
2. When you visit our websites to view, read or download information, some visitor information is collected and stored by us, such as the domain name and the host computer (the computer with which you visit the internet), the IP address (Internet Protocol) of the computer you use, the date and time you visit News.horse, and the internet address of the website from which you are linked directly to our website. With the help of this data we measure the traffic on our website and we can improve our website.
3. In addition, we collect information such as company name, name, address, telephone number, e-mail address, bank account number and Chamber of Commerce number if a company purchases a paid product or service from us.
4. Data can also be provided to News.horse via the internet in other ways, for example by filling in a (registration) form to participate in a competition, order or download a product or request a newsletter. Personal, recognizable data can also be provided to us by contacting one of our employees by e-mail, telephone or letter.
5. In most cases, the collection of your data is necessary for the performance of an agreement. Consider providing access to protected information on a website, an online application or for other services. In addition, providing your personal information gives us the opportunity to automatically offer you a number of benefits. This makes it easier for you to receive specific information such as unique login details for an online application, to participate in competitions and competitions (where we can send you confirmation or correspondence about the result, for example), personal messages and special offers. to receive information that may be relevant to you (for example, based on your surfing behavior on News.horse), to read messages about topics that you would like to read by saving your preferences or not to have to approve each time visit from News.horse. Your data also enables us to further develop and improve our website.
6. News.horse only releases personal information if it is required to do so by law. We do not sell or provide your personal information to third parties unless permission has been given.
7. News.horse does not provide any personal financial information (such as credit card information) to other parties, unless this is necessary to process your order, process our invoice, or prevent or combat fraud.
8. News.horse regularly provides links to another website. Read the privacy policy on those sites carefully, it may differ from this privacy statement.
9. News.horse uses "cookies". The following about this: in order to offer you more service when visiting websites, many websites use cookies. These are useful techniques to collect and use information. Websites are therefore easier to use. Cookies, for example, ensure that you can remain logged in to a website or that your preferences, such as location and

language settings, are remembered. They also keep track of your digital shopping cart when shopping online. Thanks to cookies, website owners can also see how often their sites - and which pages - are viewed by visitors. Furthermore, some cookies make it possible to track your surfing behavior. In this way, sites and advertisers can learn something about your preferences so that they can show more relevant advertisements. In most cases, advertisements are necessary to pay for the website. Thanks to cookies, they have been adapted as much as possible to your own interests. Cookies are stored on your computer and you can delete them at any time. That is very easy. Remember that after deleting cookies on some websites you have to set your preferences again or log in again. Important to know: The use of cookies is safe. E-mails and telemarketing campaigns are not the result of cookies. Cookies do not store your e-mail address or telephone number, nor is a profile traceable to a person using cookies. News.horse is entitled to change the content of the statements and the applications of cookies at any time and without prior notice. Consult this webpage for the most current version. 10. News.horse acknowledges the responsibility to protect the data that you entrust to us. The provider uses various recognized techniques for this, including secure servers, firewalls and encryption. An example is the SSL protocol to encrypt communication between the servers and your browser. This secure connection can be recognized by the letter "S" in the HTTPS of the URL and the green padlock in front of the URL that most browsers show. By using an SSL certificate, it is safe for you to visit our sites and share information with us.

11. Information collected by News.horse will be deleted after a while. The retention period of data depends on the purpose for which it was collected. The following usual retention periods are used: 24 hours for location data, 12 months for data used for personalized marketing, analysis and communication with you, 18 months for data used to perform an agreement.

Once you have provided us with your personally identifiable information, you have the right to object (withdrawal of prior permission), access, change, data portability (transfer of information) and the right to be forgotten.
